JOINT COMMISSION ACCREDITATION

Achieving accreditation is possible!

Preparation for Joint Commission is a collaborative, interdisciplinary effort that will span several months. The goal is to build sustainable compliance incrementally over time; to have a successful survey and then maintain compliance. Achieving accreditation requires much work on the part of the Administrator and department heads and a high level of commitment and discipline. All departments have an important role in survey preparation. However, the greatest demand will be placed on Nursing, Maintenance, Human Resources (including the Credentialing Coordinator), and Staff Development/Infection Control. The demand on other departments is generally less intense but includes a review of compliance status with all applicable standards.

One note of caution: Do not assume that you are ready for a Joint Commission survey if you've done well on your annual state inspections. This is a common misconception. There are many Joint Commission standards that do not directly crosswalk to Medicare Conditions of Participation.

The initial survey is announced. Subsequent surveys are conducted every three years and are unannounced.
